From the South...

- > Take Hwy 400 N, toward Barrie
- > At Barrie the Hwy splits, take Hwy 400 N to Parry Sound/Sudbury
- > Hwy 400 N will become Hwy 69 at Parry Sound

> Continue on Hwy 69 to Hwy 64, turn right

> Signs will indicate Sturgeon Falls

> Continue on Hwy 64 (east) through Alban & Noelville -- watch for signs -- at big stone Church mid-town

Noelville, turn right on Hwy 64

*> Continue on Hwy 64, passing through Monerville and North Monerville (approx. 15 kms)

*> Stay on Hwy 64 (approx. 5 more kms) and turn left on *Pinewood Road* (gravel road)

*> *Watch for Camp Noronto signs*

From the northwest...

> Take Hwy 69 south to Junction Hwys 69 & 64

> Turn left on Hwy 64

From the northeast...

> Take Hwy 17 west from North Bay

> pass through the Town of Sturgeon Falls

> Continue on Hwy 17 west to Verner

> At Verner turn left on Hwy 64 south

> Continue on Hwy 64 south passing through Lavigne

> on Hwy 64 (approx. 25 kms) turn right on *Pinewood Road* (gravel road)
