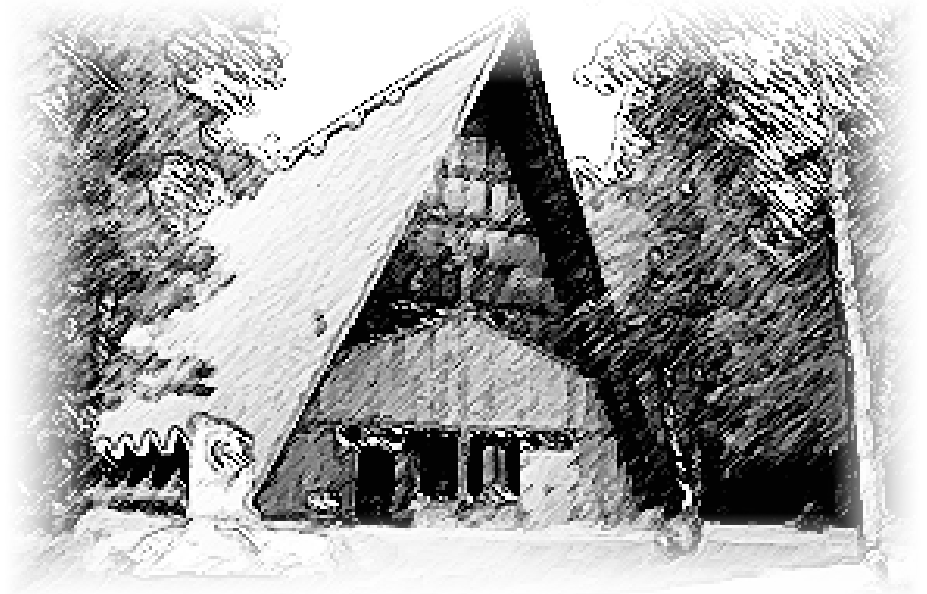

- Please take necessary health precautions for sun exposure and insect bites.

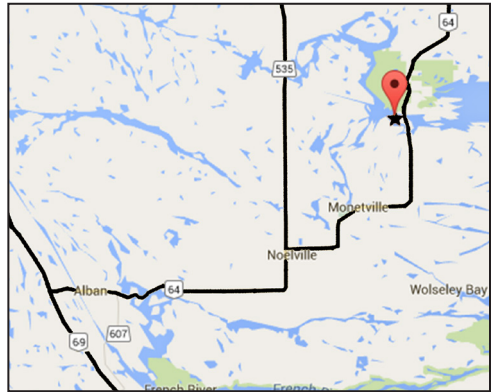
SOME CAMPGROUND RULES:
